

FISU AMERICA FÚTBOL 11

GENERAL TERMS

Article 1.

FISU America Football 11 Uruguay 2024 will be organized by the most recent technical regulations of the International Federation of Football Association (FIFA). In case of disagreement in the interpretation of these rules, the English text will be considered authoritative.

Participation will be by Universities and will be a qualifier for the FISU University Football World Cup 2025 in Dalian, China.

The III FISU America Football Uruguay 2024 will take place from May 22 to June 2.

Article 2.

The III FISU America Football 2024 includes the following events;

- One (1) men's tournament eight (8) to sixteen (16) teams maximum.
- One (1) women's tournament eight (8) to twelve (16) teams at most.

Article 3.

For each tournament, each selected University is authorized to register:

- One (1) team of twenty (20) players for each Branch (2 goalkeepers)
- A maximum of five (5) officers (HoD included).

If you want more officials to participate than allowed, said request must be made to the Organizing Committee who will stipulate the cost and whether it is possible or not.

At the first general technical meeting, the head of delegation or his representative will confirm and sign the official list of competitors.

Any registration not duly confirmed at the first General Technical Meeting will not be taken into consideration except due to force majeure.

Article 4.

The competition will be held by Universities. Each country can participate with 2 teams (from different universities) per gender.

Article 5. Selection

For the selection of teams, where the number of registrations is greater than the authorized participation level, the following criteria will be applied:

- a) Registration/nomination and payment of the guarantee.

b) The teams that finished in the top half of the FISU Games competition America above will be automatically qualified to participate; but must comply with the conditions of the FISU America entry procedure.

c) The team from the host country is automatically qualified and will be able to register a maximum of 2 teams in each branch.

The remaining participating teams will be selected by a wild card system according to the criteria defined by the OC and FISU America (geographical and subcontinental representation, FISU America classification, FISU classification, FIFA classification).

FISU America will announce the selection of participating teams no later than a (1) month before the FISU opening ceremony America Football 2024.

Article 6. Deposits

Participating countries must pay a deposit of 4000 USD to guarantee the team's participation.

This deposit must be paid to the Organizing Committee no later than April 1st; otherwise, the registration will not be taken into account.

Article 7. Draw

A FISU America classification will be established for the group draw based on the following criteria:

- a) When participating, the host country is automatically qualified and placed in group A, position 1 (A1).
- b) Participation in the University World Cup.
- c) Previous results of the FISU America Games.
- d) FIFA classification: top level and age group, as applicable.

Article 8. Deadlines

Selected teams must confirm their arrival and departure to the Organizing Committee no later than one (1) month before the start of the tournament. Any country that does not comply with this obligation may be considered withdrawn and a team from the reserve list may be invited to replace it.

The selected teams must arrive at the sports village at least twenty-four (24) hours before their first competence.

Teams that arrive late will be fined fifty percent (50%) of the team's sports deposit. The fine will be charged to the delegations by the Organizing Committee upon arrival at the Accreditation Center.

Your late arrival and failure to comply with FISU America Regulations will be referred to the FISU America Disciplinary Committee for further action.

Teams arriving late will not be guaranteed to receive their accreditation on time and may be responsible for disqualification from the competition.

TECHNICAL OFFICERS



Article 9. Nomination





The international technical officials are nominated by the National University Sports Federations (NUSF), these will be selected by the OC and the FISU America. The costs of complete accommodation, food, and fees will be divided between the participating countries, travel expenses will be covered by the applicant countries.

The Organizing Committee will announce the sum three (3) months before the FISU Opening Ceremony America Football 2024 based on team notes.

The countries participating in the event can provide to the Organizing Committee three (3) months before the opening ceremony of the III FISU America Football 2024 the names of two (2) referees (1 effective + 1 substitute who does not travel) per team.

The CO and the FISU America will appoint the National Technical Officers (NTOs) to complement the team of officials and technicians necessary for the event. The number of NTOs must be agreed between the CO and FISU America.

Article 10. Number of international technical officers

There will be as many referees as there are teams

* Each country may bring a maximum of 2 (two) referees per gender.

Article 11. Duration of stay

All international technical officials must arrive one (1) day before their first official meeting as agreed between FISU America and the CO and depart one (1) day after the end of the competition.

PARTICIPATION AND ACCREDITATION REQUIREMENTS:

Article 12°

Athletes must be at least 18 years old and no more than 25 years old (born between January 1, 1999 and December 31, 2006).

Article 13

Student-athletes with academic status updated to the school year in which the event will be held may participate and must present the FISU America eligibility form digitally and integrate it into the computer accreditation system.

Article 14

The following student-athletes may also participate:

- Students graduating in 2023, must present the certificate of graduation, with the signature and seal of their authority or document that accredits their condition.

Article 15

For registration and participation, student-athletes and officials must follow and comply with the registration procedure in the following steps:

- Step 1) General Registration. Complete the first part of the form: here the Federations complete their intention to participate and several teams until March 22, 2024.

- Step 2) Quantitative registration. Here they will complete the name of the participating universities and the number of people who will attend the event in the teams and extras up to 2 months before the event: March 22, 2024.

- Step 3) Individual registration: this is carried out by incorporating the details of each participant in detail. Your personal, sports, eligibility, and arrival and departure data at the location, until April 22, 2024.

- General Registration Closing Date: Final date for the NUSF (National University Sports Federation) to register your country as a participant in the event.
- Quantitative Registration Closing: Final date for the NUSF (National University Sports Federation) to register their teams and the number of participants.
- Individual Registration Closing Date: The final date that the NUSF (National University Sports Federation) has to carry out the individual registration of its participants according to the requirements of the organization.

PARTICIPATION COSTS AND GUARANTEE

Article 16

The cost of participation is US\$ 65 (sixty-five US dollars) per day per participating person, both student-athletes and officials. The payment must be made by bank transfer to the account provided by the organizing committee or in cash in US dollars.

Article 17° Each participant must pay a registration fee to FISU AMERICA of US\$10 (ten US dollars).

Article 18 Countries participating in the FISU AMERICA FOOTBALL URUGUAY 2024 must make a participation guarantee deposit (\$4,000 US dollars) no later than April 1, 2024. If the payment is not made, the registration will not be taken into account. Likewise, the guarantee payment will not be returned for any reason, like the other payments established in the following articles.

Article 19 100% of the participation cost must be paid on the day of entry to the Villa, the maximum date being May 22, 2024.

Article 20 In case of additional registrations, the cost of participation will be fully assumed by the delegation.

Article 21 The Organizing Committee will coordinate and provide each participant with accommodation, food, internal transportation, and first aid. However, air transportation or international land transportation for arrival and departure, as well as those expenses incurred before the day of official arrival and official departure, will be assumed by

each participating team. They must also have traveler's insurance.

Article 22 The referees will be appointed jointly by AFU and the Technical Delegate of FISU America.

Article 23 If you incur additional expenses and costs during your stay, as well as damage to facilities, they will be assumed by each participating University.

HEAD OF DELEGATION

Article 24 The Head of Delegation is the person who represents the institution in the meetings that are called. Likewise, he is responsible for processing the documentation of his delegation.

Article 25 The Head of Delegation is obliged to ensure the good behavior of his/her players, within the sports venue and accommodation, with them and the player being jointly and severally financially responsible for any damage that the team may cause.

CEREMONIES AND AWARDS

Article 26° As part of their participation, the NUSF must attend official ceremonies properly uniformed (inauguration ceremony, closing ceremony, welcome ceremony, and any other act that can be considered official). The Organizing Committee will inform the time, place, and procedure.

Article 27 The merit awards will be:

- Trophies: To the first three places.
- Medals: To the first three places.
- Certificates of Participation: Virtual certificates will be delivered to all participants who have completed the registration process.

IMAGE RIGHT

Article 28

By registering for the event, all participants, whether professional players or not, automatically, free of charge and with full rights, expressly and irrevocably and irrevocably authorize The free use of any upload or charge of their name, their image and your voice in photos, files and/or digital or non-digital media, as well as in posters, banners, films and/or spots, jingles and/or vignettes, in any type of media and/or promotional pieces, including television, radio, newspapers, posters, banners, direct mail, internet. In other words, tangible or intangible assets, for the wide dissemination of the championship. The authorization described above does not imply or entail any obligation of disclosure or payment. The winners agree to authorize the use of their images, voice sounds, and names, on TV, movies, videos, photos and posters, and advertisements in newspapers and magazines, for an indefinite period, for the dissemination of prizes or participation in future tournaments, as well as the use of the data contained in the registration to communicate future promotional actions, without any burden for the organization of the competition.

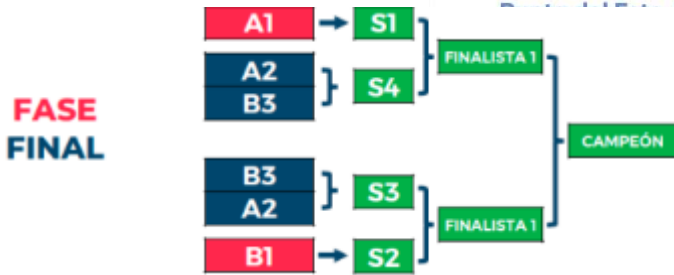

- With six (6) teams registered in a tournament, First phase, two groups of 03 teams each. There will be 03 dates in the first phase. The format of the tournament will be all against all. The 06 teams will go to the next round: Final Phase.



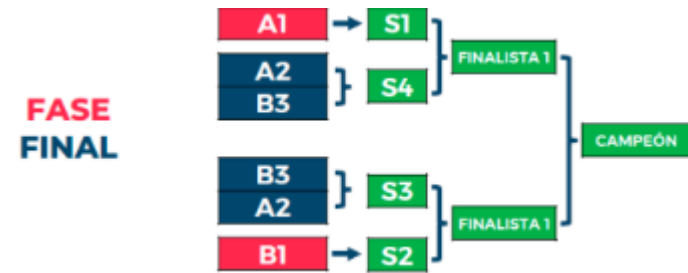
Final Phase, the format will be brackets and simple elimination (single match), according to the graph.



- The first place in groups A and B will go directly to the semifinal stage.
- The teams that win in the quarterfinal round will qualify for the semifinal stage of the tournament.
- The 02 teams that lose in the semifinal round will play for third and fourth place in the tournament.
- The 02 teams that win in the semifinal round will qualify for the Grand Final of the tournament.

> With seven (7) teams registered in a tournament, The first phase, is made up of groups: Group A with 4 teams, group B with 3 teams. There will be 03 dates in the first phase. The format of the tournament will be all against all. The top 3 places in each group advance to the final phase.

Final Phase, the format will be brackets and simple elimination (single match), according to the graph.



- The first place in groups A and B will go directly to the semifinal stage.
- The teams that win in the quarterfinal round will qualify for the semifinal stage of the tournament.
- The 02 teams that lose in the semifinal round will play for third and fourth place in the tournament.
- The 02 teams that win in the semifinal round will qualify for the Grand Final of the tournament.

> With eight (8) teams registered in a tournament, The first phase will be made up of 02 groups of 04 teams each. There will be 03 dates in the first phase. The format of the tournament will be all against all.

The 08 teams enter the second phase of the tournament.
 - The Second Phase will be made up of 08 teams that will play in the quarterfinals of the tournament. It will be a simple eliminatory: single match (see image).



- The 04 teams that win in the quarterfinal round will qualify for the semifinal stage of the tournament.

The 02 teams that win in the semifinal stage will qualify for the Grand Final of the tournament.

The 02 teams that lose in the semifinal stage will play for third and fourth place in the tournament.

- The 04 teams that lose in the quarterfinal round will play for fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth place in the tournament.

The 02 teams that lose will compete for seventh and eighth place in the tournament.

The 02 teams that win will compete for fifth and sixth place in the tournament.

> With nine (9) teams registered in a tournament,

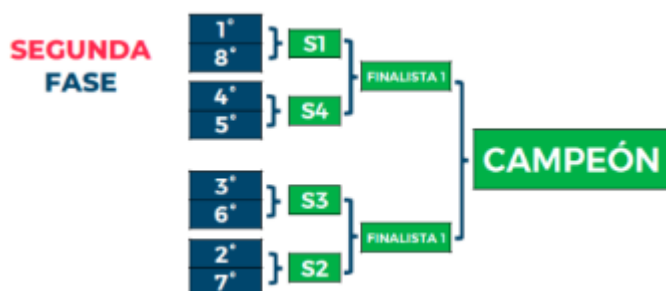
First phase will be made up of 03 groups of 03 teams each. There will be 03 dates in the first phase.

The 08 best teams will enter the second phase of the tournament.

Second Phase: The 08 best teams will play in the quarterfinals of the tournament.

- The 02 teams that lose in the semifinal stage will play for third and fourth place in the tournament.

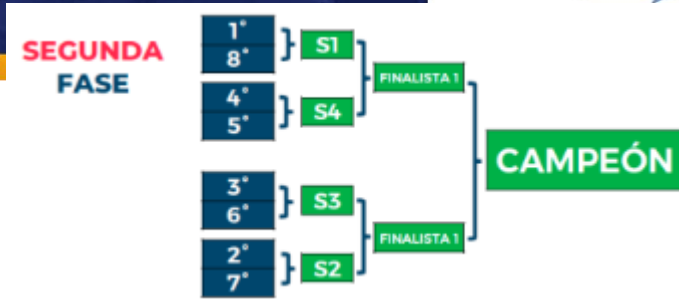

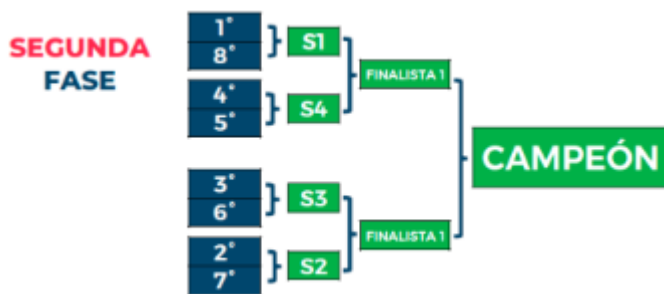
Second Phase: The 08 best teams will play in the quarterfinals of the tournament.

The second phase will include 03 dates. Key format with single elimination: single match (see image)



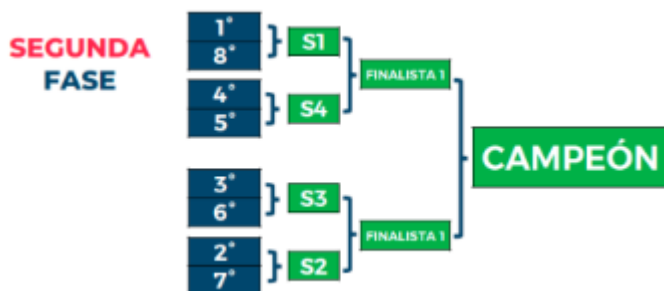

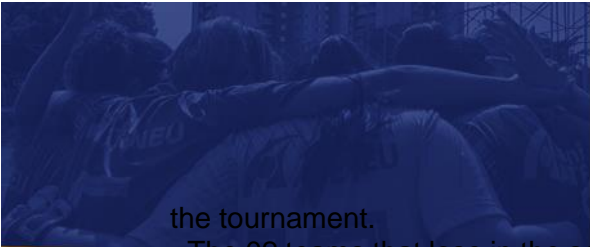

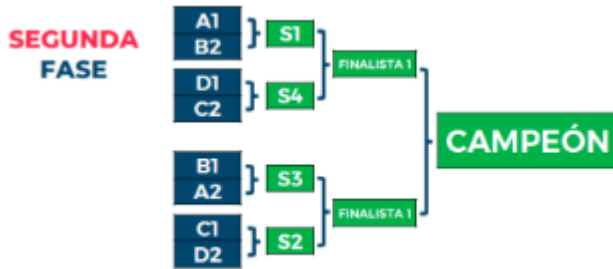

The second phase will include 03 dates. Single elimination key format: single match. (view image)



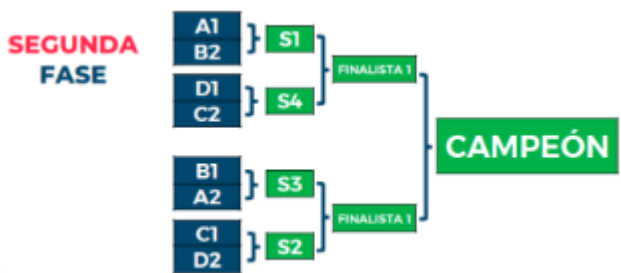

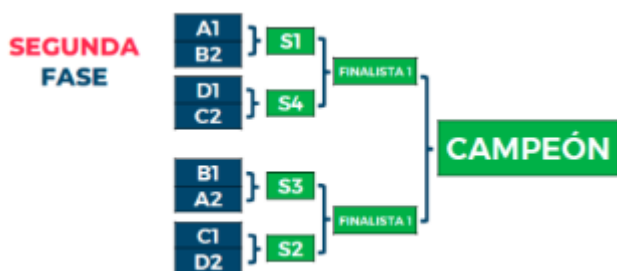
